



Admission to the First Year of the English-taught Master's Degree Program in "Medicine and Surgery"

AVAILABLE SEATS

Applications are now open for the admission to the English-taught Master's Degree Program in Medicine and Surgery at the Rome Campus of Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore. The following number of seats is available:

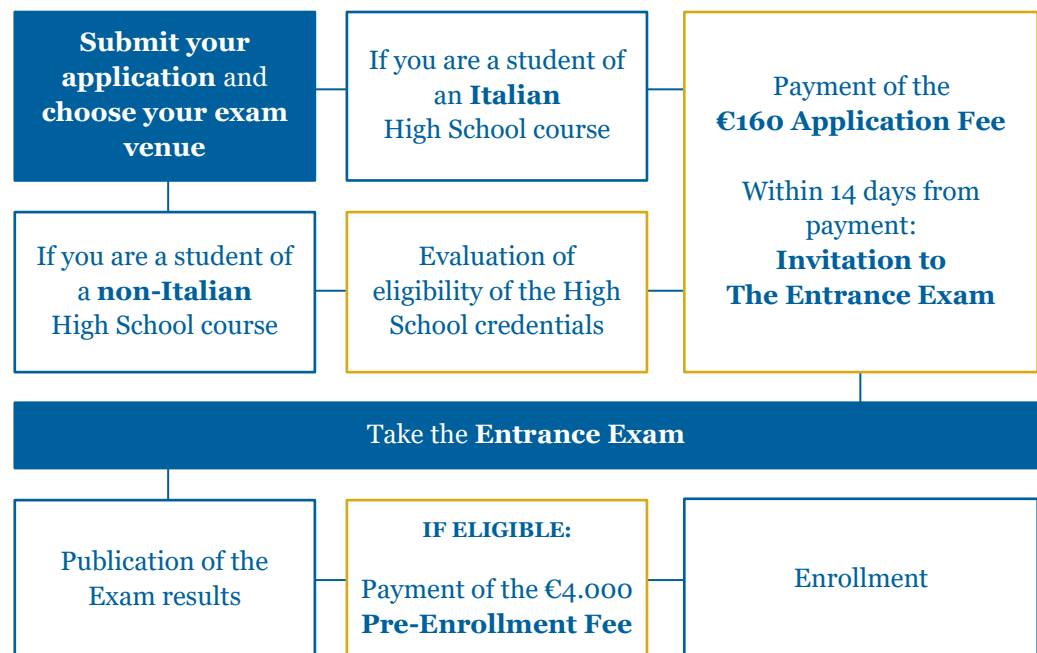
20 seats for Italian and EU citizens living anywhere and non-EU citizens who are already living in Italy legally (with a "*permesso di soggiorno*" / residence permit);

30 seats for non-EU citizens living abroad.

How to apply to Medicine and Surgery - 1

HIGH SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS

- Being enrolled in the final year of a High School course; or
- having already obtained a High School qualification, either Italian or non-Italian.

Non-Italian High School Qualifications must be obtained after **at least 12 years of global schooling**. They also must be eligible for the admission to Italian University Programs.

Depending on the regulations of their Country, applicants with **less than 12 years of global schooling** are required to submit a certification of:

- either the “*Academic Eligibility*”; or
- any post-High School courses, along with a corresponding transcript and the documentation indicating the formative contents.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Step A – Submitting your application (by February 1, 2019)

For students of **Italian** High School courses:

- Access <http://roma.unicatt.it>;
- Enter the section labelled *Ammissione a Medicina and Surgery a.a.2019/20*;
- Click on “*Sistema di iscrizione online*”;
- Follow the on-screen instructions: fill in the online form and choose your preferred Exam Venue.

For students of **non-Italian** High School courses:

- Access <http://www.ucscinternational.it>;
- Click on the following tabs:
 - *Programs*
 - *Bachelor Degrees in English*
 - *MD in Medicine and Surgery*
- Read the instructions and documents, then click on “*Apply Now*”;
- Follow the on-screen instructions: fill in the online form and choose your preferred Exam Venue;
- Non-Italian High School qualifications will be subject to an evaluation in order to verify the eligibility to access Italian University Programs;
- You will receive an official response on the eligibility of your High School qualification shortly after.
- If your eligibility is confirmed, you can proceed to Step B and pay the €160 Application Fee.



How to apply to Medicine and Surgery - 2

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Step B – Pay the €160 Application Fee (by February 12, 2019)

In order to finalize your application, it is mandatory to pay an Application Fee amounting to **€160**.

The payment must be made **no later than February 12, 2019** and any applicant who completes this payment after the deadline will **not** be allowed to take the Entrance Exam.

Please note that the receipt of the payment will be required on the day of the Exam.

The Application Fee is not refundable in any circumstance.

For students of **Italian** High School courses:

- After completing the Online Application form, you will be able to print a MAV payment slip of **€160** that you can use to pay the Application Fee.

For students of **non-Italian** High School courses:

- If the eligibility of your High School Qualification has been confirmed, you will receive **a new e-mail message** and your application form will be updated.
- Follow the on-screen instructions. You will be allowed to pay the **€160** Application Fee by Credit Card.

Once the payment of the Application Fee has been registered, applicants may also access an **online simulator** to prepare for the Entrance Exam.

This simulator features a database of more than 3.000 question items tailored to the Exam and made available as a tool for the individual preparation of the applicants.

Step C – Invitation to the Exam (within 14 days from payment)

Within 14 days from the payment of the €160 Application Fee, you will receive a new e-mail message with a confirmation of the Exam Venue that you have been assigned to.

Moreover, the official Invitation List containing the final assignments for the Entrance Exam locations will be published on **February 21, 2019** on <http://roma.unicatt.it>.



For applicants with Disabilities and/or Learning Disorders

PROCEDURE

For applicants with Disabilities

For students of **Italian** High School courses:

- Access <http://roma.unicatt.it> and log into your Application Form;
- You will find a specific section of the online form labelled “Candidati con disabilità e/o affetti da D.S.A”
- Upload the official certification attesting your disability from within the interface no later than February 1, 2019.
- You may be granted up to 50% additional time to complete the Entrance Exam.

For students of **non-Italian** High School courses:

- Access <http://www.ucscinternational.it>;
- Click on the following tabs:
 - *Programs*
 - *Bachelor Degrees in English*
 - *MD in Medicine and Surgery*
- Download the form to request special support (“compensatory tools”) for the Entrance Exam;
- Fill out the form, then send the official certification attesting your disability along with the form in question **by e-mail to international.admissions-rm@unicatt.it** no later than February 1, 2019.
- You may be granted up to 50% additional time to complete the Entrance Exam.

PROCEDURE

For applicants with Learning Disorders

- Access <http://roma.unicatt.it> and log into your Application Form;
- You will find a specific section of the online form labelled “Candidati con disabilità e/o affetti da D.S.A”
- Upload the official certification attesting your learning disorder from within the interface no later than February 1, 2019.
- You may be granted up to 30% additional time and the use of extra tools to complete the Entrance Exam.
- Applicants are required to submit a certification of their Learning Disorder which must have been issued no more than three years before by a nationally accredited structure;
- It is mandatory to send the documentation **by e-mail to international.admissions-rm@unicatt.it** no later than February 1, 2019.
- You may be granted up to 30% additional time and the use of extra tools to complete the Entrance Exam.

Please note: For any medical certification issued outside of Italy, the applicant **needs to also submit an official translation in Italian of the same document.**

In all Countries where the professional role of the official translator is legally established and used for such purposes, the conformity of the translation will be declared by the translator and then legalized by the respective Consular office. In those Countries where the professional role of the official translator is not legally established and used for such purposes, the user needs to refer directly to the respective Consular office in order to validate the documentation.



Medicine and Surgery Entrance Exam

Admission to the English-taught Degree Program in *Medicine and Surgery* is determined exclusively by the results of a **computer-based Entrance Exam**.

STRUCTURE

- **65 questions (total)**
 - **2 questions** on general knowledge;
 - **20 questions** on logic-related subjects;
 - **18 questions** on Biology;
 - **12 questions** on Chemistry;
 - **8 questions** on Physics and Math;
 - **5 questions** on religious and ethical culture.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

- **+1 points** for each **correct** answer;
- **Minus 0.25 points** for each **wrong** answer;
- **No points** for each question left **blank / unanswered**.

The minimum threshold required to pass the Exam is **15** out of a maximum of **65 points**.

The Exam has a total duration of **65 minutes**.

TIMETABLE AND VENUES

The Entrance Exam will take place on **February 27, 2019 at 2.00 pm** for all available venues, although the definitive timetable may be changed for organizational reasons. All applicants will be able to choose their preferred Exam Venue among a list of options available while filling out the Application Form.

Within 14 days from the payment of the €160 Application Fee, users will receive a new e-mail message confirming the timetable and Exam venue that they have been assigned to.

The final Invitation List, detailing the timetable and Exam venue for each applicant, will be published on <http://roma.unicatt.it> by **February 21, 2019**.

Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore reserves the right to modify the date, timetable and venue of the Entrance Exam at any time, should this be required for organizational reasons.

On the day of the Exam, applicants are required to provide the Commission with a valid ID document among the following:

- ID Card / ID Document / Driving license;
- in the case of non-Italian EU students, a valid passport;
- in the case of non-EU students already living in Italy, a valid residence permit.

Applicants need to also show the **payment receipt of the €160 Application Fee**, as well as any document certifying disabilities or learning disorders.

It is **forbidden** for any applicant to use mobile phones, tablets, laptops, calculators, books, notes or any web-connecting device during the Entrance Exam.

Applicants who arrive after completion of the identification process will **not** be allowed to take the Exam.



Results of the Exam and Pre-Enrollment Procedure

PUBLICATION OF THE RANKINGS

The final rankings indicating the score achieved in the Entrance Exam will be published on <http://roma.unicatt.it> starting from **March 7, 2019**.

Applicants who achieve the first useful positions in the rankings will be selected as the winners of this competition and thus may pre-Enroll in the Program.

PRE-ENROLLMENT

The winners of this competition may pre-enroll in Medicine and Surgery by completing all the steps outlined here **no later than March 22, 2019**.

Any applicant who does not complete either of the following steps by this deadline will **not** be allowed to finalize their Pre-Enrollment. In any such case, any remaining vacant place will be made available for the other applicants in the waiting-list.

For students of Italian High School courses:

- Access your Online Application on <http://roma.unicatt.it>.
- From within the interface upload a scan copy of your ID document; your Certificate of Baptism (or a statement that attests your commitment to attend an interview with our Ecclesial Assistant); a passport-size picture in color.
- Confirm the information pertaining to your High School studies. If you have yet to attain your High School Diploma, choose the corresponding option.
- After doing all the above, you will be able to generate and print a MAV payment slip amounting to **€4.000**, that you may use to perform this payment through a local Bank or an online-banking interface.
- Once you have finalized your payment, send the receipt of your €4.000 Pre-Enrollment Fee payment by e-mail to ammissioni-rm@unicatt.it

For students of non-Italian High School courses:

- You must make this payment by means of a **Bank / Wire Transfer**, using the following parameters:

- Once you have finalized your payment, send 1) a Statement of Acceptance; 2) your Certificate of Baptism (or a statement that attests your commitment to attend an interview with our Ecclesial Assistant); 3) the receipt of your €4.000 Pre-Enrollment Fee payment by e-mail to international.admissions-rm@unicatt.it.

Please note: the €4.000 Pre-Enrollment Fee is not refundable in any circumstance.



Enrollment Procedure - 1

Starting from July 1, 2019 and no later than September 6, 2019 all pre-enrolled students are required to finalize their Enrollment by submitting the following documents.

Any winner of the competition who does not comply with the terms herein indicated will **not** be allowed to enroll in the Program and their position in the ranking will be considered as **withdrawn**.

- ❑ Enrollment Form
- ❑ Statement Form concerning the Country of Income

Applicants will be provided with the instructions to obtain the documents in question by e-mail.

- ❑ **For students of Italian High School courses** - Either a copy of the original High School Diploma; or a substitute self-declaration of the same achievement.
- ❑ **For students of non-Italian High School courses** – A copy of the original High School Diploma / Qualification; **and**
Depending on both local and Italian regulations, the accompanying **Dichiarazione di Valore** (Statement of Validity) that must be issued by the Italian Embassy / Consulate in the Country where the Diploma was awarded.

*The **Dichiarazione di Valore** is an official document which provides a description of a student's Qualification, its validity in the awarding Country for academic and / or professional purposes, as well as the legal status of the awarding Institution. We highly encourage all international students to apply for it upon completing their Pre-Enrollment.*

- ❑ Payment receipt of the €4.000 Pre-Enrollment Fee
- ❑ Two passport-size photos (with the candidate's name and surname written on their back side)
- ❑ A photocopy of the student's ID document / ID Card / Passport.
- ❑ A photocopy of an Italian *Codice Fiscale* (tax / fiscal code).

*The *Codice Fiscale* is an Italian document issued by the Government offices or by Italian Embassies / Consulates, consisting of a 16-character alphanumeric code that is provided free of charge. It is an essential document that is needed to identify both Italian nationals and foreign residents and allow any financial operations.*



Enrollment Procedure - 2

- ❑ An English Language Certification, satisfying the types and minimum scores:
 - **ACADEMIC IELTS** – 6.0; or
 - **TOEFL IBT** – 80; or
 - **TOEFL Computer Based** – 213; or
 - **TOEFL Paper Based** – 550; or
 - **CAMBRIDGE ESOL** – FCE “First Certificate” with “GRADE B”.

- ❑ **For non-EU applicants that were already living in Italy at the time of applying for the test** - A photocopy of a valid residence permit
- ❑ **For non-EU applicants that were living abroad at the time of applying for the test** - A valid Visa for Study-related reasons (TYPE D), issued by an Italian Embassy / Consulate.

The Visa is a document issued by the Italian Embassies / Consulates, enabling a student to stay in Italy for study-related reasons. All students who do not have a EU nationality are required to go to their Italian Embassy / Consulate and apply for a Visa after completing their Pre-Enrollment procedure.

- ❑ Certificate of vaccination for Hepatitis B
- ❑ Certificate of anti-tuberculin Mantoux test, performed no more than 3 months before submission

The medical certification in question need to be submitted within 60 days from the completion of the Enrollment procedure.

For students of **Italian** High School courses:

It is mandatory to submit all the above to the **Front-Office of the Student Service** (Polo Servizio Carriera Studenti) located in Largo Francesco Vito 1, 00168 Rome no later than September 6, 2019.

For students of **non-Italian** High School courses:

It is mandatory to submit (either in person or by post) all the above to the **International Office of the Rome Campus**, located in Room 230 of the *Istituti Biologici* structure (Facoltà di Medicina e Chirurgia), in Largo Francesco Vito 1, 00168 Rome no later than September 6, 2019.
